## WHO IS LIKELY TO BENEFIT FROM THE HEALTHIER SG CHRONIC TIER?

- ✓ Patients with higher chronic medication needs and bills which exceed the current CHAS annual subsidy limits are more likely to benefit. Patients with lower medication needs, may continue to be covered by existing CHAS subsidies.
- ✓ Consult your family doctor to find out if you are suitable to switch to the common chronic medications under the Healthier SG Chronic Tier.

<sup>2</sup> Other medications refer to medications which are not defined in the HSG Whitelist. The HSG Whitelist comprises medications commonly used at the polyclinics for the management of CDMP conditions.

<sup>3</sup> Applies to medications on the HSG whitelist which are under the Standard Drug List (SDL). Details of the subsidy levels for medications on the HSG whitelist which are under the Medication Assistance Fund (MAF) will be released subsequently.

<sup>4</sup> "Simple" refers to visits for a single chronic condition. "Complex" refers to visits for multiple chronic conditions, or a single chronic condition with complication(s).

## CARDHOLDERS RECEIVE HELP IN THESE TWO AREAS:



For common chronic medications, receive subsidies of up to 87.5% with no dollar cap, based on the card status.



For other services (e.g. consultations, investigations) and medications, receive subsidies of up to \$135 per visit and \$360 per year.

At every visit, CHAS/PG/MG cardholders can choose to either tap on subsidies under the existing CHAS Chronic Tier, or the new Healthier SG Chronic Tier.

# HEALTHIER SG HELPS YOU IN 5 KEY WAYS:

## 1 SCREENINGS AND VACCINATIONS

Benefit from fully-subsidised nationally-recommended screenings and vaccinations such as influenza shots, based on your age, health conditions and vaccination history, for Singapore Citizens.

Early detection and treatment can help prevent or delay the onset of common chronic conditions and cancers such as diabetes, high blood pressure and cholesterol, colorectal cancer, breast cancer, and cervical cancer.



## 2 ACCESS TO SUBSIDISED SPECIALIST CARE

Get referrals to public specialist outpatient clinics (SOC) for CHAS, Merdeka Generation (MG) and Pioneer Generation (PG) cardholders at all Healthier SG clinics. Receive affordable specialist care, without having to visit polyclinics for referral.

## 3 HEALTH PLAN FOLLOW-UP

Start your health journey with a fully-subsidised Health Plan consultation at your first visit to your Healthier SG clinic, and ensure good progress with free annual check-ins, either by phone or during your other medical appointments\*.

\*Prevailing fees for services outside Healthier SG scope will apply.

## 4 OUT-OF-POCKET PAYMENTS

From early 2024, use MediSave to fully pay for chronic conditions treatment under the Chronic Disease Management Programme (CDMP) without cash co-payment, up to the MediSave withdrawal limit.

## 5 SUBSIDIES ON COMMON CHRONIC MEDICATION

From early 2024, CHAS/PG/MG cardholders enrolled to Healthier SG GP clinics with higher chronic medication needs will enjoy more subsidies under the new Healthier SG Chronic Tier.
